Art Squad Daily Schedule & Class Descriptions Summer 2011

9:00-9:10 am Arrival

The day begins for Art Squad with checking in with their counselor under the tent and hearing morning announcements.

9:15-10:05 am Period 1 - Sports/Mini Musical

There will be a choice of field games or music class. Campers will be offered a range of outdoor sports that may include kickball, Frisbee, basketball, tag, capture the flag and soccer. In MINI MUSICAL the class will work together to create a show based on a popular story, complete with original songs and choreography. No previous experience necessary. The final products will be performed at Noontime Shows and at the Arts Festival.

10:10-11:00 am Period 2 - Art Buffet

There will be a variety of art offerings each week, from drawing and painting to clay and sculpture. We will often be working outside, using nature for our inspiration.

11:05-11:55 am Period 3- Story Theatre

A Dr. Seuss book, a Robert McCloskey story, what will it be? Come and help pick the story we will make into a play. Everyone will be a part of the magic of making a book come to life and we'll perform our tale at the Noontime Show and on Festival Day.

12:00 pm Lunch

We will have lunch, provided by Hearth Stone Pizza, at a designated table either inside or outside depending upon the weather.

12:30 pm Noontime Show

Daily performances by campers and counselors. Parents are welcome.

1:00-1:50 pm Festival Period

Each day we will get to choose an activity - it could be sports or art or drama or dance or music.

1:55-2:45 pm Period 5

Swimming Level 1 & 2 Students will become comfortable in the water. They will learn to put their faces in the water and also how to float (stomach and back). We will be developing a foundation of safety skills.

2:50-3:40 pm Period 6 - Squad Time/Optional Early Pick-up

As the day winds down, Art Squad campers will have an opportunity to eat a snack, try a new craft or enjoy quiet playtime with friends. We will try activities such as book and journal making, tie dye, puppet making, sketching, creating mobiles and crafts with objects found on nature walks.
